ADEQUATE YEARLY PROGRESS

No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) goals must be met by all schools. NCLB expectations are 22.3% Proficient in English and 20.9% in Math. All students must take tests at grade level with schools required to test above 95% of enrollment.

NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND GRADUATION RATES

Rowland Unified School District posted a 99.8% district graduation rate with the State goal being 82.9%. The average Los Angeles County school rate is 79.3%.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE — Highest ever record

The daily attendance rate of 96.8%, with your school's rate at 96.6%, which was one of the highest rates ever!

CALIFORNIA HIGH SCHOOL EXIT EXAMINATION

The California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) is required to be passed for both English and Math to receive a High School Diploma beginning with the class of 2006, with their cumulative passing rates reported in this summary as of March 2006.

The average first time pass rate for the State in English is 74% and in Math 75%.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

Each year students who are acquiring English skills are assessed with the California English Language Development Test (CELDT). This test measures student's progress toward English fluency with the goal of reaching reasonable fluency defined as Early Advanced or above.

Last year the district tested 9704 English Language Learners on the CELDT Test.

STAR - STANDARDIZED TESTING AND REPORTING

Students are assessed each year on the California Standards Tests. These results are the primary component used in determining AYP and API scores for each school. The average scaled score and percentage of students Basic (300) or above for each subject is reported in the chart below:

A scaled score of 300 is the minimum required to reach the basic level.

HIGHLY QUALIFIED TEACHERS

No Child Left Behind set out very rigorous qualification and certification requirements for teachers that must be met by 2006. Under this complicated formula that is reported by subject area 92.3% of RUSD teachers met the criteria in their current teaching assignment. Teachers at your school met this strict criteria last year.

The district employs 813 teachers, of which 87.5% have taken additional college coursework beyond a bachelor's degree. In addition 39.4% of Rowland's teachers, and 51.5% of your school's teachers, hold a Masters degree or above!
