HOW YOUR PROPERTY TAX BILL IS CREATED AND WHAT OFFICE TO CONTACT FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

It takes three separate Los Angeles County offices, ASSESSOR, AUDITOR-CONTROLLER, and TREASURER AND TAX COLLECTOR to produce and account for your property tax bill and payment.

The Los Angeles County ASSESSOR establishes the assessed value of your property by appraising the value of that property under applicable State law. The assessed value of your property is placed on the "Assessment Roll." The Assessor also approves and applies all exemptions which are included in the Assessment Roll. The Roll is then presented to the Los Angeles County Auditor-Controller for further processing.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY ASSESSMENT APPEALS BOARD

The property taxes you pay are primarily based on your property's assessed value as determined by the Los Angeles County Assessor. If you disagree with the assessed value placed on your property, you can file an appeal with the ASSESSMENT APPEALS BOARD during the filing periods stated below.

The application filing periods for assessment appeals are: Regular Assessments - filing date is July 2 to November 30.

Supplemental/Adjusted/Escape/Roll Corrections - filing date is no later than 60 days after the mailing date on the Notice of Assessed Value Change or Supplemental/Adjusted/Escape Assessments Tax Bill.

Misfortune & Calamity Reassessments - file within six months of the mailing date of the Assessor's proposed reassessment notice due to property damaged by misfortune or calamity.

Electronic Check Processing - When you provide a check as payment, you authorize the County of Los Angeles to either use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your bank account or process the payment as a check transaction.
